We saw or contacted 16 Neighbors this week. There were 6 in need of CenterPoint help, some with more than a thousand dollars in arrears. Though we can only help with some money, we do try to co-ordinate our efforts with the Township Trustee, CAPE, and other organizations to get their power restored. We had one grandmother who has taken her 15-year-old grandson in. His mother is incarcerated, and his father is not in the picture. He had been sleeping on the couch and needed a Sleep in Heavenly Peace bed. This wonderful woman has had several sets of foster children over the years, and is wise in the ways of providing a stable home, and turning these kids around. This young man has been doing better in school, has a few hours a week part time job, and seems to be doing much better under her guidance. She is doing all this while dealing with her own health issues. Thanks for making it possible for us to work with people like this—what a backstop such grandmothers are!
