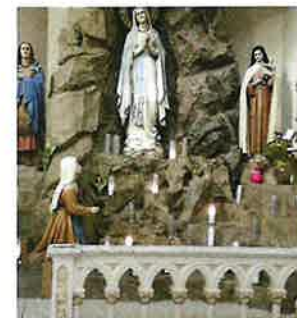
This week with your help we were able to help seven families with their Center Point bills, one family with a water bill and six families got help with their rent. We also were able to help two families with vouchers to get a bed.

St. Mary Grotto

Our Lady of Lourdes is a Roman Catholic title of the Blessed Virgin Mary venerated in honor of the Marian apparitions that allegedly occurred in Lourdes, France.



On the feast of the Annunciation of the Virgin Mary on March 25th, the Lady at last proclaimed her identity to Bernadette, saying "I am the Immaculate Conception". The solemnity of Mary's Immaculate Conception is celebrated on December 8 and honors the conception of Mary in the womb of her mother, St. Anne, without original sin. The doctrine of the Immaculate Conception had been proclaimed only a few years before, in 1854.

As we enter into May, a month dedicated to Mary, Fr. Eugene would like to present in greater detail the Virgin Mary appearing to St. Bernadette at Lourdes, France and the connection to our Grotto. Please join Fr. Eugene in church for this presentation on either of these dates...
