ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...



This week we attended to 16 Neighbors’ requests for assistance. We were able to set up four teams of two Vincentians to visit half of them, with the rest by telephone. Rent was the primary area of concern this week, as affordable housing remains a significant need in our community. It is one of the two focus areas of CAGE this year, continuing that organization’s emphasis into a second year. One Neighbor’s situation stood out. A divorced mother of 3 children, she works an \$11/hour job 30 miles away. She has to be there by 7:00 a.m. She schools two of her children in the community where her job is located, with day care for her baby. We were able to supplement what rent money she had available with enough to pay her rent this month. Her faith, however, is quite strong. Her prayer was for the Lord’s intervention in body, mind and soul. We are often exposed to such faith among the community which seeks our help, and it is both humbling and uplifting. Thanks for all you do to support this ministry. During the month of October our parish Food Pantry served 126 households which was a total of 213 of our neighbors received groceries because of your generosity.
