I find, as I age, that time seems to fly by instead of creeping. I remember it seemed like forever until Advent season, awaiting Christmas and the birth of Jesus. Well, here we are again as Advent fast approaches. This year we will again be collecting food for our Pantry ministry. This year the need is

greater as many families have had reductions in their government subsidies for food. We are all feeling the increase in buying our own groceries, paying utilities, mortgages, school expenses and on and on. I am asking for us all to share a little more this year to help those we serve. I will include a list of all we give out in our pantry to help you decide what you might bring. The greatest needs will be in all capital letters.

I also ask for contributions to our St Vincent De Paul ministry. This Outreach Ministry helps our neighbors with rent, utilities, household items, shut off notices, beds and clothing. In these uncertain times all needs have increased. Envelopes are in your monthly packet of church envelopes, or you can find St. Vincent de Paul donation envelopes in church. Lastly there will be envelopes at church labeled Christmas Year-Round. This outreach was established to help with other requests not being met by our established outreach. Examples might be necessary medicines, bus tickets for family funeral attendance etc.

help would be so grateful.
