In the past two weeks, your

St. Vincent de Paul Conference were in contact with a total of 30



households needing assistance. A week ago, the majority needed help with utilities. This week, the bulk of our Neighbors needed help with rent. Not each rent problem has a similar solution. A few Neighbors were getting into housing after homelessness, and we had to devise ways to help them obtain help from other agencies as well as ourselves to hopefully put together their first and last month's rent so that they could get in. Others needed enough to simply pay rent. Still others were under threat of eviction. Aurora is a good resource to avoid eviction, so besides helping them with some money, we got them involved with Aurora. One Neighbor just needed some help to bridge the gap between his need for rent money now, and his first paycheck from his new job. So, though the needs are common, the reasons and the solutions can vary. Thanks for all you do to support our ministry.
