With two children of her own, this is their first real housing unit after long periods of homelessness. She is getting married and her future husband has two children who are in care. Once she can demonstrate that they have enough bedding, together they can move those two additional children in with them. We are registering them for Sleep in Heavenly Peace beds. We also helped three folks with their CenterPoint bills, and two with their water bills, while we await some more details to help others. Rent and Thrift Store furniture vouchers rounded out our assignments for the week. Our SVdP family is so appreciative of the parish support to do this happy work.
