Neighbor had actually been shut off. As is our practice, we help as much

as we can, and we steer them towards other sources of help. Good News: The Sleep in Heavenly Peace ministry which furnishes beds for children between ages 3 and 17 is 5 years old this month. Because we do home visits whenever we know someone needs beds, we can do the home visit the Sleep in Heavenly Peace people would otherwise have to do. This past weekend, using 16 teams, SHP delivered 76 beds, which is twice their normal volume. They are a great resource for the poor of our community and it is something we happily partner with them on, at no cost to our Conference.







## Your Dollars Make A Difference -

- Last fiscal year, the Evansville District of St. Vincent de Paul partnered with YWCA, Ozanam Family Shelter, Salvation Army, and Aurora to provide clothing at minimal cost to those they serve.
- Provided \$680,000 in direct assistance to more than 13,000 individuals to cover rent, utilities, and other essentials.
- Distributed over 338 tons of food from our Pantry to almost 31,000 individuals.
