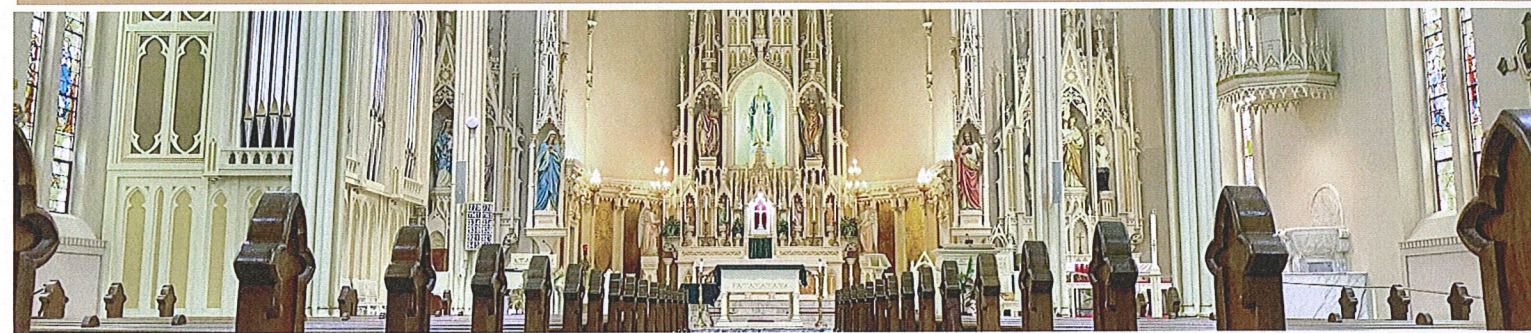

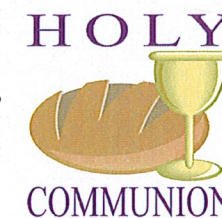


FAITH FORMATION INFORMATION
